MINUTE entry before the Honorable Mary M. Rowland: The Court held a videoconference hearing on 11/22/24 regarding a deadline to complete PFS review and to set a final deadline for plaintiffs to submit completed PFS. Parties agree there are approximately 1,100 PFS submitted by 5/31/24 that Defendants have not indicated whether the PFS is deficient or substantially complete. By 12/3/24, the parties are to identify and agree upon these 1,100 Plaintiffs. By 12/20/24, Defendants must notify Plaintiffs of any PFS deficiencies for the first 400 of these Plaintiffs. NOTE: No Plaintiff should wait to receive a deficiency notice before amending or supplementing their PFS to comply with the Court's orders. Plaintiff fact discovery to close on 2/28/25 for any Plaintiffs who filed and served their SFC by 2/1/24. All PFS are to be substantially complete by that 2/28/25. Mailed notice. (jg, )
