MINUTE entry before the Honorable Rebecca R. Pallmeyer: In-person status hearing convened. As stated on the record, the court orders: (1) By 6/23/2025, the parties will confer and submit to the court the following: a proposed selection process for the remaining bellwether cases after *Inman v. Mead Johnson* (22-cv-3737); and a proposed schedule for motion practice in the non-bellwether cases. (2) The stipulation in the *Diggs v. Abbott* case (22-cv-5356) [79] is revised as follows: In-person oral arguments for the summary judgment motions will now be heard on 7/28/2025 at 10:00 a.m. in courtroom 2503; In-person oral arguments for the Daubert motions will be heard on 7/30/2025 at 11:15 a.m. in courtroom 2503; (3) The *Inman* dispositive motion schedule is set as follows: Dispositive motions to be filed by 8/25/2025; responses are due by 9/22/2025; and replies due by 10/6/2025. (4) The following trial schedule for *Diggs* is re-set as follows: A special panel of jurors will be requested to appear on 8/4/2025 to fill out the juror questionnaires. Voir dire to stand on 8/7/2025 with opening arguments to occur on 8/8/2025. The court will issue a ruling on the pending remand motions by 6/23/2025. Mailed notice. (cp,)
