**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 29  
(Plaintiff Leadership Reappointment Process)**

On March 16, 2025, the Plaintiff leadership team was appointed to a one-year term, expiring on March 16, 2026, with the option to apply for reappointment annually. *See* Pretrial Order No. 18, ECF No. 180. This Order establishes the reappointment application process.

All Plaintiffs' counsel who wish to apply for reappointment to their leadership positions must submit applications detailing the nature and scope of counsel's work over the past year, including the time and resources they have expended. Additionally, to the extent that counsel have updated financial arrangements to fund this litigation—*see* Pretrial Order No. 5, ECF No. 96-1 at 3—counsel must include those disclosures in their applications. Applications for reappointment should be no longer than **two pages** and must be submitted via email to [flnd\\_rodgers@flnd.uscourts.gov](mailto:flnd_rodgers@flnd.uscourts.gov) by **5:00 p.m. CT** on **February 13, 2026**, for *in*

*camera* review. An attorney who fails to timely file an application for reappointment will not be reappointed to his or her leadership position.

The Court will review the submissions and, as necessary, consult with Lead and Co-Lead Counsel, as well as the committee/subcommittee chairs, about the productivity and effectiveness of the leadership structure and team. Thereafter, the Court will enter the appropriate reappointment order.
